Discovered in 1492 by Christopher Columbus, Labadee was later used as a trading post by visiting ships and their crews. The peninsula has been restored since the time of the buccaneers and now features abundant activities for guest of all ages.

Within five distinct neighborhoods – Adrenaline Beach, Columbus Cove, Buccaneer's Bay, Nellie's Beach and Labadee Town Square – Labadee is brimming with an action packed variety of features and activities, including:

- The Dragon's Breath Flight Line, which at 2,600 feet is the longest zip line in the world over water, giving guests a rush while soaring 500 feet above the beaches of Labadee
- **Dragon's Tail Coaster** a thrilling high-speed ride through 2,232 feet of the destination's tropical flora and rock formations
- The heart-racing **Dragon's Splash Waterslide**, an exciting 300 foot long saltwater slide
- Arawak Aqua Park, which features floating trampolines, inflatable iceberg shaped slides, water seesaws and more (more)

Labadee also offers a variety of water activities ranging from snorkeling and kayak adventures, to floating beach mats and banana boat rides. Suite guests can enjoy exclusive amenities including private cabanas along the water's edge and within the hillside areas.
